- P6 report any equipment faults or damage to the appropriate person(s)





- K4 the requirements for protecting the vehicle and contents from damage before, during and after working on a vehicle

- K6 the procedure for reporting faulty or damaged equipment
- K7 the importance of reporting anticipated delays to the relevant person(s) promptly
