# Automotive learners report – 2020 Q4

## Introduction

The aim of this report is to analyse the numbers undertaking automotive qualifications in the UK. The report takes data released by the 4 nation's regulatory bodies:

- OfQual The Office of Qualifications and Examinations Regulation [England]
- SQA The Scottish Qualifications Authority [Scotland]
- QiW Qualifications Wales [Wales]
- Cea The Council for Curriculum, Examinations and Assessment [Northern Ireland]

These datasets hold data on the number of certifications awarded for each qualification. This data is released on a quarterly basis with the most recent being 2020 Q4 (October to December).

With regards to qualification level, the analysis uses England & Wales's qualification levels and Scottish levels have been mapped to match these.

# Summary of findings

- In 2020, 45,899 automotive qualifications were issued, this was 30% less than 2019.
- The total number of automotive certificates issued in 2020 Q4 was 12,488. Q3 (July to September) is traditionally a peak quarter for certifications, and as such the Q4 figures have fallen. However, comparing to 2019 Q4, certificates are 33% higher. This is not the case when looking at all qualifications suggesting that for automotive there was a degree of deferred certification in Q3.
- The proportion of those undertaking level 1 automotive qualifications has increased in 2020 by 4% compared to 2019.
- The number of IMI TechSafe certificates issued in 2020 Q4 increased by almost threefold compared to Q3, but is 2% lower than the same timeframe last year.
- From 2016 Q1 to 2020 Q4, there have been 15,688 IMI TechSafe certificates issued.



# **Qualification Certifications**

The total number of certificates issued in 2020 Q4 was 883,955. This is 11% lower than the same period last year.

In 2020, 4.6 million certificates were issued, which is 27% lower than 2019.

All 4 nations have seen certifications drop comparing this quarter compared to 2019 Q4.

The total number of automotive certificates issued in 2020 Q4 was 12,488. Quarter 3 is traditionally a peak quarter for certifications, and as such this reporting quarter (Q4) has fallen. However, comparing to 2019 Q4, certificates are 33% higher. This is not the case when looking at all qualifications suggesting that for automotive there was a degree of deferred certification in Q3.



In 2020, 45,899 automotive qualifications were issued. This was 30% less than 2019. This decrease is 3% more when comparing to all qualifications.

All 4 nations saw increases in automotive certifications when comparing to 2019 Q4. The significant (all be it small numbers) being Wales which saw a 146% increase.





In 2020 Q4, the largest proportion (41%) of qualifications were at level 2 (or equivalent) with 5143 qualifications at this level, 34% were at level 3 and 20% were at entry and level 1.

#### 2020 - full year



In 2020, the largest proportion (40%) of qualifications were at level 2 (or equivalent) with 18,568 qualifications at this level, 33% were at level 3 and 24% were at entry and level 1. The proportion of those undertaking level 1 automotive qualifications has increased by 4% compared to 2019.



#### IMI TechSafe

IMI TechSafe qualification certificates issued 1,552

IMI Techsafe qualification certificates issued **15,688** 

This includes certificates up to Q4 2020. It includes all outlined IMI TechSafe qualifications including those offered by C&G and ABC not just IMI. It does not include accreditations.



The number of IMI TechSafe certificates issued in 2020 Q4 increased by almost threefold compared to the last quarter, but is 2% lower than the same timeframe last year. From 2016 Q1 to 2020 Q4, there have been 15,688 IMI TechSafe certificates issued.
