

MET NOS Changes 2024 – for wider consultation phase

Overall, the MET NOS are working well, with only minor changes required.

- Amend performance criteria regarding legal requirements to include ‘environment’ and add new supporting knowledge statement to all NOS – **‘Dispose of waste materials to conform with legal, environmental and workplace requirements’**
- Add new knowledge statement to all relevant NOS regarding **‘single use mechanical fasteners, why they are used and the dangers of not renewing them’**
- Amend scope/range for Tools and equipment to include **‘jacking and lifting’** where relevant
- Amend scope/range for Testing methods to include ‘sensory’ instead of ‘visual’ and ‘aural’ to align with other NOS
- Amend scope/range for Systems to include **‘high voltage integrated electrical systems’** and **‘electronically controlled exterior lighting’** where relevant
- Amend the glossary definition of Contaminants to include **‘high voltage batteries and electrolyte, plastics, glass, gases, fuel and hydrocarbons’** where relevant
- Amend the glossary definition of Vehicle Safety Systems to include reference to **‘ADAS systems’**
- Amend the glossary definition of Vehicles to include reference to **‘alternatively fuelled vehicles’**
- Add new glossary definition for Alternative Fuel to all relevant NOS

In addition there were a few individual amendments suggested:

- **IMIMET01**
 - Add new K9 – **‘how four wheel alignment might affect ADAS functionality’**
 - Scope/range 2 (Tools and equipment) – add **‘jacking and lifting’**
- **IMIMET02**
 - Remove the word ‘battery’ from the overview caveat - **‘This standard does not cover working on high voltage systems’**
- **IMIMET04**
 - Amend overview to include **‘regulatory requirements concerning air conditioning systems and F gas’**
 - Add new K7 – **‘the limitations of your role and responsibility’**
- **IMIMET06**
 - Scope 1.9 – amend to **‘electronic and diagnostic testing equipment’**
- **IMIMET07**

- New K6 added – **‘how and where to find relevant safety technical information’**
- Scope 2.4 – amend to **‘electronic and diagnostic testing equipment’**
- **IMIMET08**
 - **‘other refrigerants’** added to K1 and K6
 - New K4 added – **‘how and where to find relevant safety technical information’**
 - New K10 added – **‘the operating principles and function of automotive mobile air conditioning (MAC) and climate control units containing F gas refrigerants within alternative fuelled vehicles’**
 - New K13 added – **‘the hazards associated with different air conditioning systems’**
