NATIONAL QUALIFIERS May to June

- The top 16 scorers from each category will be invited to a one-day practical qualifier
- Before they will be invited to a Teams call to meet the IMI team
- An information pack will be sent to you and your apprentice with handy hints and tips on the national qualifier

 1-1 teams set up to talk through the competition's next steps and create a case study of the finalist and their employer to showcase your talent and training

FINALISTS ANNOUNCED

• On the 11th July the top 6 from each stream will be invited to the final

WORLD SKILLS UK FINAL November 25th - 28th

- After a familiarisation day there will be two days of practical tasks for the finalists
- The two-day final will then end with a medal ceremony at the ICC in Wales

SQUAD & TEAM UK November onwards

Top, age-eligible scorers asked to join Squad UK and potentially compete at an international level as part of Team UK
